Subj: ADDITIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY (DON) TESTING
DESIGNATED POSITION (TDP) LIST

Ref: (a) OCPMINST 12792.3A, DON Drug-Free Workplace Program
of 10 Sep 93

A revised DON Drug - Free Workplace Program (DFWP) Plan was submitted to the Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP) in September 1993 in conformance with an ONDCP requirement letter of 15 January 1992. This revision included all DON TDPs previously approved by ONDCP, as well as a request for inclusion of additional positions.

By undated Interagency Coordinating Group (ICG) Executive Committee (headed by ONDCP) letter received in December 1994, DON was advised that "Conveyance Operator positions subject to random testing are limited to those who transport passengers, hazardous materials, classified documents, or those who operate vehicles, vessels, or aircraft weighing in excess of 10 tons." The DON was directed to apply this restrictive language or delete the positions from our DFWP Plan. The DON was also directed in this letter to add Water Treatment Plant Operator Positions to those subject to random testing.

By direction of the ICG Executive Committee letter, DON has made the following changes to the TDP list:

Restricted Coverage:

- * Motor Vehicle Operator, WG-5703

- * Small Craft Operator, WG-5786

- * Only those positions which transport passengers, classified documents, or hazardous materials are TDPs.

Add:

Water Plant Operator, WG-5409

Water Treatment Plant Operator, WG-5409

By letter dated 13 September 1995, ONDCP approved the inclusion of the following positions as DON TDPs:

Lead Firefighter, GS-081

Supervisory Firefighter, GS-081

** Lead Detective, GS-083

** Supervisory Detective, GS-083

** Lead Criminal Investigator, GS-1811

** Supervisory Criminal Investigator, GS-1811

*** Aircraft Freight Loader, WG-6968

*** Aircraft Freight Loader, Leader, WG-6968

** Only those positions whose incumbents are required to carry firearms are TDPs.

*** Only those positions which work with explosives are TDPs.

All positions which match the basic titles listed above and meet the conditions of coverage are TDPs. Parenthetical titles do not affect coverage as TDPs. These positions supplement and will be added to the next revision of Appendix E of reference (a).

Activity heads are reminded of their responsibility to sign and distribute specific notices to all incumbents of TDPs 30 days prior to random testing. The notice is provided at Appendix D of reference (a). Additionally, these positions must be coded into the Defense Civilian Personnel Data System. Where these changes impact employees represented by labor organizations, activity heads must fulfill their bargaining obligations prior to

implementing these changes. Questions should be referred to the
Office of Civilian Personnel Management Regional Offices.
